



Dr. Charles Mugisha: Abbreviated Biography

Charles Mugisha grew up in a Rwandan family living as refugees in Uganda. After giving his life to Christ, spending several years engaged in local ministry, and wanting to pursue his education, Charles began attending Reformed Theological College in Kampala, Uganda. There, Charles met his wife, Florence, and they both went on to complete master's degrees at Multnomah University in Portland, Oregon. In 2001, while attending Multnomah, Charles wrote the ministry plan for Africa New Life. Deeply moved by what he witnessed when he returned to Rwanda after the 1994 genocide, he felt called to help.

Today, Africa New Life provides for more than 10,500 students who are working toward a high school education, vocational training, or a university degree. Charles continues to serve as the lead pastor of New Life Bible Church in Kigali and as the President of Africa New Life. Charles also earned a doctorate degree from Gordon-Conwell Seminary in 2015. Together, Charles and Florence are raising their four children, Isaac, Jonathan, Sarah, and Joseph.
